The Role of Sailing Master in Kuring-gai Yacht Club

The Sailing Master co-ordinates members and their boats when planning raft-ups, cruises and sail pasts, ensuring all members can enjoy safe, well organised boating events. The Sailing Master can be any member of the Club and does not need to be a Board Member.

Key Responsibilities

- Obtaining numbers, size & make of boats partaking in an event
- Determining order of raft-ups and sail pasts
- Be the main point of contact for on water activities (before and during the event)
- Tide charts for longer cruises eg Colo, including advising members of areas of the waterways to take or avoid
- Nautical expertise and boat handling, including boat characteristics, anchoring and knowledge of marine charts
- Help build a sense of camaraderie amongst members attending boating events
- Boat handling / training sessions
- Safety of members.
