## **Event 2. SATURDAY 26th July**

**CONVICTS, CASTLES AND CHAMPAGNE TOUR – GOAT ISLAND – COST approx. \$120 per person**

**Start time 9.45am (TBC) – finish approx. 12.45pm**

Leaving at around 9.45am (TBC) from Campbells Cove. Walk in the footsteps of Australia's early convicts and hear fascinating tales of punishment, death and escape as you take in a 1.5km tour around Goat Island.

Along the way you will encounter significant sites such as an early 1800's military gunpowder magazine, a soldier's barracks and Sydney's oldest water police station.

Afterwards board a historic timber vessel operated by the Tall Ship Company and enjoy a catered lunch on board and a cruise past some of beautiful Sydney Harbour while sipping a glass of bubbly!

The event is about 3 hours in total and is graded EASY – a basic level of fitness is required for the tour.



## **Event 3. SUNDAY 27th July**

**AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL MARITIME MUSEUM – SECRET STRIKE – WAR ON OUR SHORES – Free tour - followed by LUNCH @ Pyrmont Bay Hotel – own cost**

**Museum opens at 10am – lunch at approx. 12 noon**

This year marks the 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the end of World War II. To commemorate this the Museum is showing an exhibition focusing on the Japanese midget submarine attack on Sydney Harbour.

End the event with a long relaxing Sunday lunch at Pyrmont Bridge Hotel, a short stroll across the road from the Museum.
