BOATING SEASON OPENING DAY

In our beautiful garden setting we provide a catered luncheon. Once welcomed by a Guest Speaker, the afternoon is followed by the members and guests boarding their vessels for the annual 'Sail past and Salute'. At the end of the day, as the sun sets, the members meet for Commodore's drinks in the Clubhouse overlooking Cowan Creek.

DINNER ON THE PONTOON

Members moor their vessels 'Stern On' to the KMYC pontoon and socialise over drinks. A catered, themed dinner is served. Optional decorating of vessels and persons is encouraged. The members then relax into the evening.

OPEN AIR FILM NIGHT

The KMYC lawn in front of the Clubhouse overlooking Cowan Creek is an excellent setting for our 'Open Air Cinema', classic movie, BYO and picnic on the grass.

OFF THE WATER WEEKEND

A new location is enjoyed every year. With tours, events and dinners arranged from the Hunter to Canberra. A great opportunity to make new friends.

EASTER—COLO CRUISE

Join members of KMYC to cruise up the Hawkesbury River to the Colo River. Throw in an anchor and join in for a long weekend of fun on the banks of the river with campfire evenings, kids games and barbeques.

MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS AVAILABLE

MEMBER

Should be the owner or part-owner of a power-driven boat. The boat shall be of a minimum of 18 feet (5.5m), have overnight accommodation, cooking facilities and a head, and be moored or stored at a waterfront location. Other types of vessels, such as sailboats and motor sailboats, may be eligible for admission but only up to 25% of our total number of vessels. Only fifteen (15) moorings are allocated for these vessels. Where a boat is jointly owned, all owners of the boat must become members of the Kuring-Gai Motor Yacht Club.

REMOTE MEMBER

Any boat owner(s) as per above that don't keep their boat in KMYC 'home waters'. Home waters are Cowan Waters, Pittwater, Brisbane Waters, Berowra Waters and Hawkesbury River.

FAMILY CREW MEMBER

Eligibility is confined to sons, daughters, sons-in-law, daughters-in-law, mothers, fathers, mothers-in-law, fathers-in-law and grandchildren of Members, Remote Members and Life Members.

CREW MEMBER

A person who is one of the crew of a Member, Remote Member or Life Members' boat. A crew member must be nominated by the boat owner.

SOCIAL MEMBER

Is not an owner or part-owner of an eligible power driven boat or sail boat, nor eligible to be a Family Crew or Crew Member. A person who wishes to enjoy the facilities and social activities of the Club.

JUNIOR CREW MEMBER

Is the son, daughter or immediate close relative of a Member, Remote Member or Life Member and is under 18 years of age.

MARINE RESCUE MEMBER

Is based at Marine Rescue Cottage Point and is entitled to one parking space whilst on duty at Cottage Point.

MOORING FEES and DINGHY STORAGE

Members who are allocated a KMYC mooring will be charged according to the class of mooring they are allocated as below:

A class (up to 33 feet) - \$531 per month

B class (up to 40 feet) - \$644 per month

C class (up to 46 feet) - \$740 per month

D Class (up to 60 feet) - \$965.00 per month

Members who are allocated a KMYC dinghy storage rack will be charged \$345 per annum (including GST).

CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

1. All members are required to be properly proposed and seconded by a Member, Remote Member or Life Member of the Club and accepted by the General Committee.
2. Membership becomes effective when accepted by the General Committee and upon payment of the prescribed fees within thirty (30) days of notice.
3. Members are required to read and abide by the Constitution and the By-Laws of the Club.
4. In categories of membership 4-9 the candidate shall not be the owner or part-owner of a power driven boat, sail boat or motor sailer.



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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. On duly being elected to membership of KMYC, and after payment of fees due, MEMBERS, DEFERRED MEMBERS and REMOTE MEMBERS will receive a copy of the Constitution, a year book (containing general information about the Club), 2 Club keys and a security fob for access to the Club, 2 car stickers for parking in the grounds of KMYC, a dinghy/boat sticker and a Club burgee (to be flown when using a KMYC mooring, but may only be flown when the Member is on board).
2. FAMILY CREW, CREW, MARINE RESCUE AND SOCIAL MEMBERS will receive a copy of the Constitution, a year book, 1 Club key and security fob and 1 car sticker.
3. The Club has seventeen remote moorings throughout Refuge Bay, America Bay, Coaster's Retreat and Wondabyne for the exclusive use of KMYC members.
